

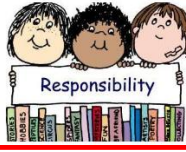

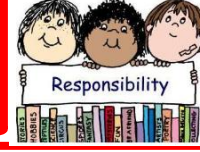

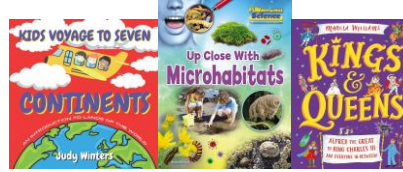
How shall we spend our money?
