Terms and Conditions

Deansbrook Infant School offers a high quality of wrap-around care including an After School Club and a daily Breakfast Club. We feel that providing this service we can support parents who work or need childcare before and after school club with qualified school staff who are familiar to the children.

- The club is led by members of school staff.
- There will be a range of infant based activities such as drawing, painting, imaginative play, games, construction activities and much more!
- A nutritious snack consisting of a sandwich, fruit and fruit squash/water will be available each day.
- Regular Sessions at Rainbow Club can be booked for all or part of a week and should be booked at the beginning of each half term.
- Occasional additional sessions can be booked if there is the capacity available.
- Occasional sessions must be booked at least one week in advance.
- Bookings can be made at the school office.
- Payments will **not** be refunded if a child is ill or does not attend Rainbow club for any reason. Should the school be closed for an exceptional reason (e.g. snow days/unavoidable emergencies/industrial action) a credit for that day will be made by the school.
- Payments **must not** be allowed to fall into arrears and late payment may result in your child's place at Rainbow Club being forfeited.
- Snack (Sandwich, fruit and fruit squash/water) will be included in the price of a session. **There is no reduction in cost for a child who does not eat a snack.**
- Once a child has been offered a regular place, the place will remain available to that child for that term.
- Payments are to be made online via SchoolMoney. A text with your log in details will be sent to you once your booking has been confirmed. Payment receipts will be issued via email.
- Parents eligible for free school meals can pay the discounted rate of £7.00/£10.00 per session. We will check your eligibility once you have made your booking.

Costs

Standard rate: – Sessions 1 – 3.15pm – 4.30pm - £8.00 per day

Discounted rate: - 3.15pm – 4.30pm - £7.00 per day for those eligible for Pupil Premium funding

Standard rate: – Sessions 2 – 3.15pm – 6.00pm £12.00 per day

Discounted rate: 3.15pm – 6.00pm -£10.00 per day for those eligible for Pupil Premium funding
