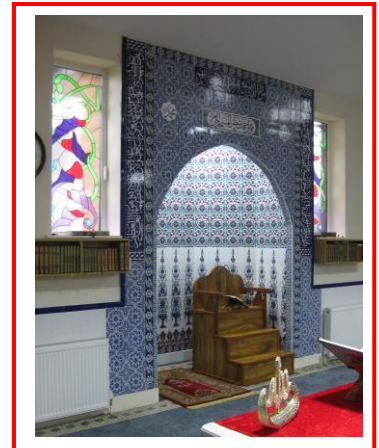
Message from Mrs Catley

Year 2 visit to the Edgware Islamic Centre



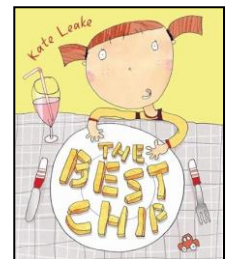

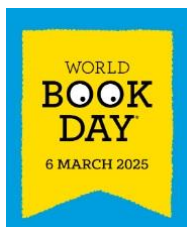
