Nick asked why the government funding for Cost Of Living increase to staff salaries was less than the actual cost; CC explained that the funding was driven by no. of children not by cost of staff, so given our staff are more expensive than average the funding will be insufficient for the additional cost incurred.  JHS queried why energy costs were higher than we had provisioned. CC explained that we had reduced our provision for energy based on the guidance from the Borough, but the recommended amount had proved to be too low.  Nikki queried the split of energy costs between the Infant and Junior Schol.  Action: JP to record electricity daily at 4pm and 6pm to get a view on consumption from Busy Bees.  CC explained the cost and impact of the increase in mobility (no. of children leaving and joining). She gave the example of a new child recently joining in Year 1 who speaks no English and has never been to school at the age of 6 years. She also cited another child who has been allocated to the school this week who has complex learning needs.  CC noted that we now have several children with more complex needs, so a separate classroom has been set up for those 5 children.
