Therefore, your child does not need to bring a water bottle to school.

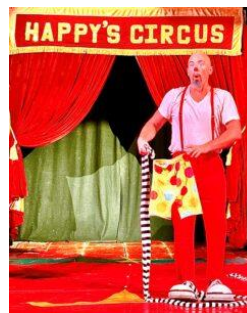
Please do not bring water bottles to school
