Year 2 visit to St. Paul's Cathedral

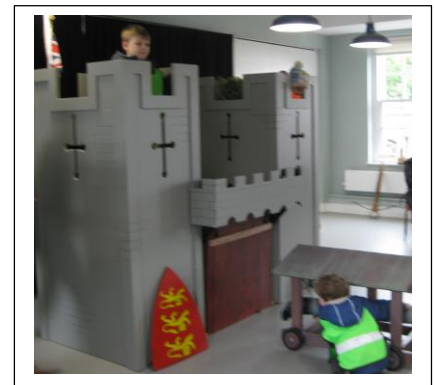
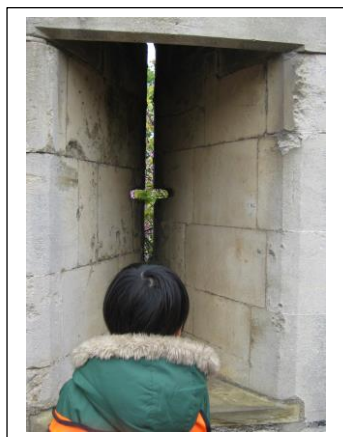


Year 2 visited St Paul's Cathedral this week as part of their history work on the great fire of London. It was a fantastic experience starting by travelling on a London bus and a tube train. Then they went into the cathedral and learnt a little about the history of the building. They then re-enacted part of the story of the Great Fire.

After lunch they climbed up 259 steps to see the amazing view across London from the roof of the cathedral.

Finally, the children walked to Pudding Lane, where the fire started, and saw the monument built to commemorate the Great Fire.
