The centre site

The children will walk to the bus stop at Cloister Gardens and catch the 292 to A1 Barnet Way.




They get off the bus half way up the A1 and then cross the road using the subway to walk to the Moat Mount Centre.

Outdoor Centre Layout




Upper Floor


The Activity Room

The Bedrooms



- The bedrooms are downstairs
- 2 girls' rooms and 2 boys' rooms
- Each room has 4 bunk beds





- The staff bedrooms are situated next to the children's rooms with two beds in each.

Each bedroom has small windows which open enough to allow fresh air only.



- Each window also has a grill for added safety.



- There are three showers in each bathroom.
- These are very well maintained and are clean and hygienic.

During the afternoon the children take part in various team building activities.

Qualified instructors supervise.

Every child is given the opportunity to have a go



Children go on a nature walk and look for some of the local trees and plants.



As part of the nature walk the children collect items to make natural sculptures.



The children also have the chance to play team games and co-operation games such as the parachute.
