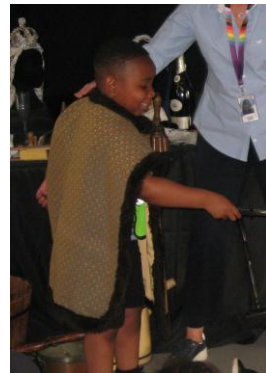
## Message from Mrs Catley

Please come to the school office.

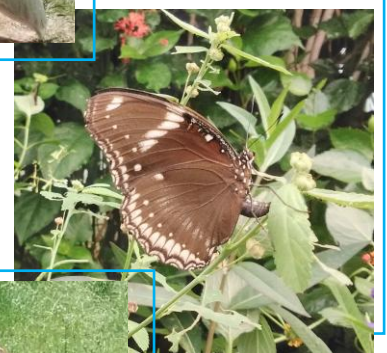
### Reception visit to London Zoo
