

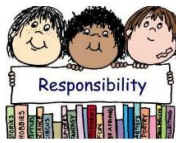

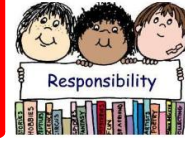

We need as many parents/carers as possible to help make our summer fair a success.

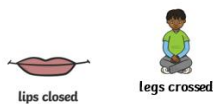
