Next week they are going to paint and decorate their fish sculptures using some special metallic paints.

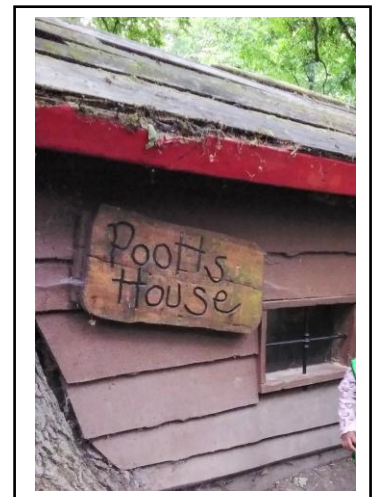
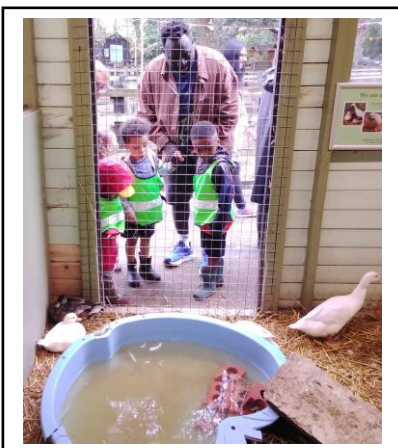
Year 1 Art

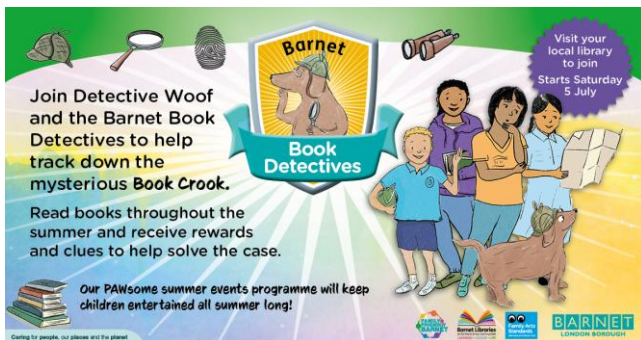
