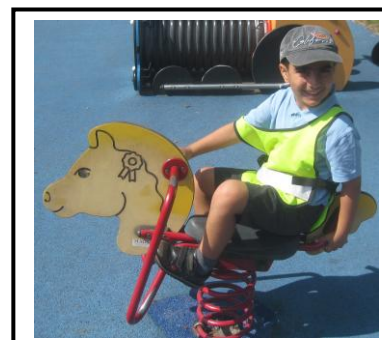
Is your child in Year 2?
